Entry Requirements

or

A Bachelor's degree in any of the disciplines including 30 credits related to the Social Sciences/ Peace/ Development Studies

or

A Bachelor's degree in any of the disciplines or completion of NVQL-7 and a minimum of two year work experience in a relevant field.

Rs. 155,000 (Payable in two installments)

Scholarships

A limited number of tuition waiver scholarships are available for most needy students. Further, full scholarships including airfare and monthly stipend will be offered for selected number of students based on their academic performances, to follow their third semester studies in Tribhuvan University, Nepal.
