Eligibility for admission into the Ph.D. program

Short-listed candidates will be called for interview and asked to present their proposals for Ph.D. research. Selected candidate(s) will be requested to register at the Tribhuvan University in Nepal. Fellowships will cover all tuition fees, field expenses and a nominal monthly stipend.
