## **Guidelines for the Competition**

The Theme of the oratory competition 2015 is

## "Indigenous Knowledge for Development"

- Competition is open for undergraduate students.
- Competition is conducted in Sinhala, English and Tamil mediums.
- The time period for an oration is limited to <u>seven minutes</u>.
- The competition will be conducted in three rounds; faculty, inter-faculty and the final.
- At the Faculty Level Competition, each faculty is requested to select two best speakers from three mediums. At the inter-faculty competition, best three contestants from each language category is selected
- The Grand Finale and the Awarding Ceremony will be held with the participation of the
  Vice Chancellor, University of Ruhuna and the Indian Consul General of Hambantota.
- All Selections will be done by a panel of experts within and outside the university.
- Evaluations will be based on the vision on the topic, technical soundness of the speech and analysis of the topic, oratory skills and time management.
- The Best Orator of the each language category will be awarded medals (Orator of the Year 2015) and a certificate,
- The nine best speeches will be published as an edited booklet along with digital format.
