before **31stJanuary 2013** will be considered for publication in the first issue of the journal.

- It should be ensured that the manuscripts are originals neither published nor under consideration for publication elsewhere
- The journal only accepts manuscripts written in English. The length of the paper should not exceed 25 pages.
- The abstract should be concise and factual with maximum (250 words). Provide a maximum of 5 keywords that best describes your research paper.
- Divide the article into clearly defined and numbered sections. Subsections should be numbered 1, 2. (then 1.1, 1.1.1, 1.1.2), 1.2, etc
- **Citations and References:** Guidelines specified in the **Publication Manual of the** American Psychological Association (5th edition, 2001) must be followed.

A consolidated alphabetical list of all books, articles, essays and theses referred to (including any referred to in the tables, graphs and maps) in the text should be provided at the end of the article.

References for tables and figures should accompany the table or figure. If more than one publication by the same author is listed, the items should be given in chronological order. References should be embedded in text in the author-date method of citation. For example: (Konhert, 2007, p. 12), (Kannabiran et al., 2008, pp. 175–200).
