SUBMISSION GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACTS AND FULL PAPERS

General Instructions

Papers must be original contributions that have not been previously published or not in a review process of another conference or publication. Papers should be submitted electronically to icme2013@gmail.com as a MS word document using the ICME2013 paper submission format by the deadlines. Papers must be in English.

Submission of Abstracts

An abstract of 200-250 words of the paper with author/s information must be submitted initially. Keep line spacing at 1.5. Font size is 9 of Georgia. Provide 3-5 Keywords in the abstract.

Submission of the Full paper

The title page must contain the abstract and author/s information including affiliation/s and e-mail address/s. The length of the paper must not exceed 10 pages. The paper must state the introduction, problem, review of relevant literature, study design and methods, data analysis, discussion and conclusion

Headings:

First Order Heading Styles: Capitalize each word. Second Order Headings: Capitalize each word. Italicize. No bold. Third Order and Fourth Order Headings: Capitalize each word. Italicize. No bold. Font size is 10 for all headings.

All tables should be numbered in Arabic numerals. Title should be placed above table and centred. Capitalize each word in the title. Only horizontal lines should be used inside a table, to distinguish column headings from the body of the table. Tables must be embedded into the text at the right place All tables should be numbered in Arabic numerals

All illustrations are to be referred to as figures.
Capitalize each word in the title. Figures must be
embedded into the text at the right place. All figures
should be numbered in Arabic numerals. The Figure
number and caption should be typed above the illustration and centred.
