Calling application for the Vice-Chancellor's Awards-2020

The following six categories of awards are given under the Vice Chancellor's Awards Scheme.

- 1. The Most Outstanding Scholar
- 2. The Most Outstanding Young Researcher
- 3. The Most Outstanding Staff Inventor/Innovator
- 4. The Most Outstanding Student Inventor/Innovator
- 5. The Highest Recipient of Grants
- 6. The Most Outstanding Convener of International Conferences/Promoter of International Relations

Applications will be entertained up to 15th January 2021 for the above Vice-Chancellor's Awards.

- For Award 1, 2, and 6, all the achievements up to the 31st December of the year of award will be considered.
- For Award 4, all the achievements during the studentship up to of the 31st December of the year of award will be considered.
- For Award 3, 5 and 6, achievements which obtained 3 years prior to 31st December of the year of award will be considered.

No formal application forms are available for the above awards and the applicants should submit self-prepared applications in keeping with the general guidelines and criteria given in the annex. However, the applicants are allowed to include any additional information relevant to the awards applied in the application. Relevant supporting documents in support of all claims should be attached where appropriate.

The application will be evaluated by a panel comprising the Vice-Chancellor (Chairman), Deputy Vice-Chancellor, All Deans and Librarian and their decision will be the final. Marks will be allocated strictly based on documentary evidence submitted. The winners will receive a certificate and a trophy and will be published in the next issue of the University Newsletter.

Applications or supplementary documents submitted after the closing date will not be considered.
