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Message from the FOUNTAIN Coordinator

Dear Colleagues,

This is the first edition of the FOUNTAIN newsletter, which has been prepared for the project called "Fostering Sustainable University-Industry Techno-Entrepreneurial Collaborations and Innovations in Asian Universities." The initiative is co-funded by the Erasmus+ programme of the European Union. It is clear in today's age of economic globalization that university education produces few research and innovation results, has little impact on industry and the community, and lacks well-developed cooperation between universities and industries.

Therefore, universities and enterprises have different expectations for collaboration results, which are further exacerbated by differences in organizational and cultural factors. These disparities provide significant obstacles for forming alliances, resulting in dissatisfaction and a diminished will to maintain cooperative efforts for all parties concerned. Moreover, the rigidity of institutions, together with their hierarchical communication methods, bureaucratic obstacles, and insufficient focus on fostering a culture that prioritizes achieving results, has hindered the effectiveness of collaborative endeavours.

The FOUNTAIN initiative aims to address the lack of strong collaborations between Asian universities and industries. It will primarily focus on improving students' job prospects, incorporating blended learning methods, fostering invention and innovation, promoting techno-entrepreneurial skills, developing curricula, conducting interdisciplinary research, and implementing other related projects. The project aims to identify and document deficiencies in University-Industry Collaboration (UIC) by conducting needs assessments in cooperation with partners in Thailand and Sri Lanka. The FOUNTAIN initiative seeks to synchronize the goals of the industry with the interests of the nation, namely in the field of agro-industries. The objective is to enhance university curricula by incorporating comprehensive industrial training programmes, strengthen the relationship between universities and businesses,

establish a collaborative network in the agroindustry sector involving both university and industry stakeholders, facilitate the implementation of ideas, and promote the establishment of new business ventures. The initiative seeks to utilize the current knowledge resources available at universities in order to foster invention, innovation, and entrepreneurship. Furthermore, the planned center of excellence in the invention, innovation, and entrepreneurship aims to enhance the connections among universities, industry, and research bodies. This cooperative endeavour seeks to address the requirements of individuals who have completed their studies, scholars, agriculturalists, Small and Medium-sized Enterprises (SMEs), and other sectors within the nation and the wider area.

Moreover, entrepreneurship has gained significant prominence in the business domain due to its substantial contributions to the economies of Asian nations and European countries. The analysis, absorption, and implementation of new technologies present difficulties and also prospects for entrepreneurship, impacting virtually every sector. Many modern studies emphasize the need of considering the ethical and sustainability components of entrepreneurial ventures, especially while seeking financial success by using constantly evolving technology. The importance of technoentrepreneurial education is being recognized by higher education authorities globally and governments, which invest in entrepreneurship education. The ongoing argument shows that technology-empowered entrepreneurship may revitalize and restructure society and economies. This newsletter will help the project's goals of sustainable university-industry technoactive, entrepreneurial interactions and innovations by sharing knowledge to all stakeholders.
