**Establishment of National Expert Database on  
Air Quality Management (AQM)**

Air Resource Management Unit & National Ozone Unit of the Ministry of Environment, Sri Lanka is developing a National Expert Database to maintain a register of scientific and technical national expert team to support national air quality management initiatives, including air quality monitoring, policy formulation, modeling, health impact assessments and research and development. This database will serve as a primary source for systematically identify and mobilize national expertise for serving in national committees, task forces, representing international events and recruiting consultants for short-term and long-term assignments.

The key objective is to identify and register national experts with technical expertise in air quality management to:

- Support national policy advocacy for air pollution prevention and mitigation
- Provide technical support for designing clean air management strategies and action plans
- Strengthen national capacities in air quality monitoring and impact assessment
- Strengthen national and international partnerships in air quality management
- Strengthen legal and institutional framework in air quality monitoring and management
- Ensure effective and efficient decision making in addressing national air quality management issues

Interested experts should have experience in one or more of the following areas: air quality monitoring & instrumentation, air quality modelling & emission inventory, air quality policy & management, human health & impact assessment, ecological impact assessment, indoor air pollution management, communication and outreach, institutional and legal aspects and international protocols and agreements.

Interested experts must submit the updated CV highlighting relevant experience and publication list with covering letter briefly describing air quality management expertise. All information provided will be used solely for official purposes of the Ministry of Environment and handled in accordance with applicable data protection and confidentiality requirements.
